

WASHINTON LAKE TOWNSHIP RECYCLING

The recycling program is funded through the Solid Waste Fee which is paid by property owners in Sibley County. The site is to be used by Sibley County Residents ONLY. The program is for household recyclable materials. The contract for the recycling program is with Waste Management.

There will be three (3) 6 yard containers available for use 24 hours a day. Recyclables can be mixed together - called single stream recycling. Cardboard can be mixed with paper & glass & plastic, etc.



Acceptable Recyclable items are:

- **Paper:** Newspapers, Shoppers, magazines, office paper, paperback books & phonebooks, etc.
- **Cardboard:** Corrugated cardboard & paperboard boxes & cardboard materials.
**Please make sure the boxes are collapsed or broken down.
- **Metals:** Aluminum, steel, tin cans, pie tins, cake pans or steel food, soup or beverage cans.
- **Glass:** Bottles or jars, clear, brown, blue or green.
- **Plastics:** #'s 1 through 6 – milk, beverage & laundry detergent bottles, ice cream pails, butter tubs, etc.

Unacceptable items are:

- **NO** window pane, auto or kitchenware, Pyrex glass, clay pots, dishes, or ceramics.
- **NO** Styrofoam or packaging.
- **NO** gift wrap or food plastic wrap.
- **NO** Plastic toys.
- **NO** batteries, demolition debris, concrete, sheetrock or wood etc.
- **NO** garbage or hazardous waste, paint latex, oil or ANY liquids.
- **NO** light bulbs, TV's, appliances, electronics, toasters, coffee pots, VCR's, phones, etc.
- **NO** tires, rims or auto parts.
- **NO** mattress or box springs.
- **NO** furniture, tables, chairs lamps, etc.

****Any abuse in the form of illegal dumping or vandalism may result in the termination of this recycling program. The site is governed by MN Statutes 400, 115A, 115.071 & 116.072.
