Article 100 “General Provisions” of the Code of Ordinances of the County of Sibley

ARTICLE 100. GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 100.1 General Provisions

SUBD. 100.1.1 Short Title

100.1.1.1 This entire Ordinance shall be known as the “Sibley County Code”, and will be referred to herein as “this ordinance”.

SUBD. 100.1.2 Purpose and Intent

100.1.2.1 The Sibley County Code is enacted for the following purposes:

- a) to promote the health, safety and public welfare;
- b) to safeguard the best interests of Sibley County;
- c) to bring together various ordinances passed over a period of time;
- d) to create a comprehensive code containing the various ordinances adopted by Sibley County that will be available to the public and will be maintained;
- e) to not change the existing ordinances, unless state laws have changed so that the ordinances need to be changed;

100.1.2.2 The Sibley County Code is enacted pursuant to Minnesota Statute §375.52 which authorizes counties to create a comprehensive county code; and pursuant to the various authorities cited in the individual articles contained in the code.

SUBD. 100.1.3 Methodology

100.1.3.1 The Sibley County Code shall be divided into the following broad categories:

- Title 100 General Provisions
- Title 200 Reserved for the Future Use
- Title 300 Zoning/Land Use
- Title 400 Reserved for Future Use
- Title 500 Public Safety
- Title 600 Reserved for Future Use
- Title 700 Public Health
- Title 800 Miscellaneous
- Title 900 Administrative

100.1.3.2 All future modifications, amendments or additions to the Sibley County Code will be placed in the above categories as appropriate.

100.1.3.3 The normal numbering sequence of articles within the Sibley County Code is as follows:
