WHAT IS MEDIA MADNESS?

Introducing a BRAND NEW opportunity open to ANYONE interested in video production, not just existing 4-Hers! The new 4-H Media Madness Challenge asks youth to explore and develop media-based solutions, using scientific and engineering principles, to issues they have identified in their communities. Youth teams will work with local partners to explore issues and find solutions to challenges in topics of interest and develop videos to express their solution to an identified issue. Participants will then attend a Film Festival held in Winthrop, MN to present their 4-H Media Madness Video project.



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

- Teams consist of 3-5 youth who have completed grade 6+ by the end of the '16-'17 school year and two Adult Volunteer Coaches.
- Youth may enroll just to participate in Media Madness and do not need to join an existing club to participate, but can also be a member from an existing club or project.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR TEAM

Team registration must be initiated by the adult volunteer coaches and is done through 4-H Online. Once the coaches register the team through 4-H Online, the additional team members can then sign up. Final deadline for team registration is Friday, June 30th.
