Notice is hereby given that a general election will be held in Sibley County on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 for the purpose of electing candidates for the offices listed below. The filing period for these offices begins at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 22, 2018 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5, 2018. Candidates may file in person or by mail. Candidates who will be absent from the State during the filing period may arrange to file, in person, prior to departure. Note: Filing documents may be executed on May 28 although filing offices will be closed on May 28, 2018 in observance of Memorial Day. (*MN Statutes 204B.06/.11 and MN Statutes 204B.33.*)
