### Consolidation of the Duties of the Offices of Sibley County Auditor and Sibley County Treasurer Prior to Statutory Combination of the Code of Ordinances of the County of Sibley

**ARTICLE 830            SIBLEY COUNTY CONSOLIDATION OF THE OFFICES  
OF SIBLEY COUNTY AUDITOR & SIBLEY COUNTY  
TREASURER PRIOR TO STATUTORY COMBINATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Sibley County Board of Commissioners has passed Resolution No. 2013-73 to consolidate the offices of Sibley County Auditor and Sibley County Treasurer pursuant to Minnesota Statute §375A.10 subd. 5, to provide for the election or the appointment of the single office of Sibley County Auditor-Treasurer to take effect on Monday January 7, 2019, or on Monday, January 5, 2015, depending on the circumstances.

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statute §375A.11 permits the County Board to assign additional duties, and consolidate the duties of two or more county offices for additional compensation for the additional duties.

**WHEREAS**, the Sibley County Board of Commissioners want to provide for the contingency if either the current auditor or treasurer should vacate their office mid-term.

**WHEREAS**, the Sibley County Board of Commissioners believe there would be additional efficiencies for the County by a consolidation of duties, until the consolidated office is created.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Sibley, Minnesota, do hereby **ORDAIN** as follows:

1. That if either of the Offices of Sibley County Auditor or Sibley County Treasurer should become vacant before the consolidation of the Offices of the Sibley County Auditor and the Sibley County Treasurer as provided for in Resolution No. 2013-73, then pursuant to Minnesota Statute §375A.11, subd. 1, the County Board shall assign the duties of the vacant office to the other office until the effective date of the consolidation.
2. This Ordinance shall be filed in the Sibley County Code of Ordinance as Article 830.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication of this ordinance in the County's official newspaper.
